Forward

Many Rector cousins are concerned that publishing personal information such as is contained in this booklet might, in the hands of the unscrupulous, cause harm to an individual. Furthermore, information such as name, age, place of birth, parent's names, and work history, might find its way into databases that would be used for making legal sales and promotional contacts. Based on these expressed concerns, the decision was made a year ago to limit information presented on The Bullock and Rector Family Homepage on the internet to individuals born before 1900. As you read this booklet and enjoy learning about your present Rector relatives, remember that the information contained herein is meant for use within the family only. Believe it or not, there are many list makers out there that would dearly love to have this information for their use. The booklet has been put together by and for the descendants of Stephen Milton Rector only and will not be shared with libraries, genealogical societies, or historians.

Note: In response to the above, this privatized version has no detailed information on living persons.

This booklet is comprised of two parts. First, in Chapters 1 through 5 an attempt is been made to gather information on all of the descendants of Stephen Milton Rector and Minnie Nichols up to this date. In addition, information is presented on the descendants of Stephen Milton Rector and his first wife, Jennie D. Hawley, in Chapters 6 and 7. Family group sheets, including photos, if available, are shown for families of descendants down through the grandchildren of Stephen and Minnie. Information on further descendants is presented in the genealogy charts for each of the four children of Stephen and Minnie. These descendants include several great-great-grandchildren of Stephen and Minnie. Every attempt has been made to acquire information on all descendants.

The second part, Chapters 8 through 10, contains information on the ancestors of Stephen and Minnie. Stephen's ancestors are traced back to Andrew Rector (born in 1762 in Columbia County) and then back to John Andreas Richter who came from the Rheinland Palatinate, part of present day Germany, to England and then to New York in 1710. Minnie's lineage has not been traced but some speculative possibilities are discussed.

The index at the end of this booklet is an index of individuals only, not places. Names in the text portions of the booklet, such as this forward, are not included in the index. Individual's names in the family group sheets, genealogy reports and descendants charts are indexed.

The first efforts, among the descendants of Stephen and Minnie, to put a Rector genealogy together appeared on three ditto (the blue on white process used by many teachers) sheets put together by my Aunt Elizabeth "Bess" Rector. It presents the Rector information contained in the History of Yates County by Stafford C. Cleveland published in 1873 and adds on several new generations with names but no dates. There is no date on the genealogy but it is estimated that it was printed in 1963. My mother's copy had several hand written entries. When my mother died in 1973, I was given custody of her Rector folder and her Bullock folder but it wasn't until 1980 that I became interested in getting involved in trying to extend the record. Around that time, I took a trip to Penn Yan and while at the Oliver House found out that Alan Stuart Rector's wife, Esther Jean McMaster Rector, was also doing some work on the Rector line. Esther has continued to gather information on the present generation of Rectors and also locate information and newspaper articles on Rectors of old. Her contributions have been significant in the development of this project.

In 1983, I published a booklet on the history and a little pamphlet on the Rector About three years ago, my brothers Phil, Bob (until he died in 1998) and I started to gather as many Rector and Bullock pictures that we our hands on. The family pictures were from many sources, scanned (digitized), and original sent back to the owner. Many of pictures have been put on the Bullock and Family Home Page on the internet for our cousins to enjoy. I now have more than 2000 photos taken between the years 1860 and



Bullock history. and Cal together could lay gathered the these Rector many family 1999.

An example of one of these important family photos, shown at the right, is of the two oldest living descendants of Stephen and Minnie Rector. In the summer of 1999, Arthur Franklin "Frank" Swarthout (81) and Philip Gerald Bullock (83) got together at a Rector reunion at Barbara Mary Swarthout Crans home.

Many Rector family cousins have supplied information and photos related to the present generations of Rectors and in many cases supplied critical information on our Rector ancestors. Stephen Milton Rector, Jennie D. Hawley and Minnie Nichols

Stephen Milton "SM" Rector was born in 1853, probably on his father's farm in the Town of Benton, Yates County. His father was Jacob T. (probably Teal) Rector and his mother was Catherine Baker. Stephen's great grandfather, Andrew Rector, came to Benton from Columbia County, NY in 1817 with his wife, Charity Rockefeller, and most of their nine children. Andrew Rector's name in Columbia County was Andreas Richter. Although it is not known exactly who Andreas' parents were, it is known that the Richters in that area were descendants of Richters who came from the Rheinland Palitinate in 1710. The portrait of Stephen Rector to the right was probably taken at the time of his first marriage.



Sometime in the 1860s Jacob T. moved his family to Milo Township, Yates, NY. Stephen married Jennie D. Hawley (sometimes spelled Halley or Holley) in the late 1870s; Jennie D. was the daughter of Thomas Jefferson Hawley and Deborah A. Bodel Hawley who lived in Middlesex, Yates, NY. Stephen and Jennie lived in Gorham, NY where son Milton Medford Rector was born in 1879 and daughter Catherine in 1882. Probably Stephen and his family went to live with Jacob T. in Milo after his brother



Medford died in 1882; Medford was working his father's farm. The Rector homestead was located on Hoyt Road in Second Milo. *A photo of the homestead taken in the early 1920s is shown to the left.* Daughter S. Inez was born in 1885 and she died when she was a year and a half old. Her mother, Jennie, died seven months later in December, 1887.

Stephen married Minnie B. Nichols in

August 1888. Minnie was a few months shy of 16 when they were married. Minnie's background is, for the most part, unknown. Her birthplace is listed as Rhode Island and her father's name is Thomas Nichols in the Milo Town Clerk's records of her marriage and the birth of her firstborn. There is some evidence that she and Frances Harmon Townsend McGilliard were sisters. Stephen and Minnie lived at the Rector homestead until the 1920s and their children were Mary Florence, Thomas Jefferson, Helen Egeria, and Arthur Frederick. Stephen was a farmer, carpenter, lightning rod contractor, and township superintendent of roads. The Rectors were members of the Second Milo Baptist Church. Stephen died in 1928 and Minnie in 1938. They both are buried in Second Milo Cemetery, Yates County, NY.

Mary Florence Rector and Homer Bullock



Homer Bullock was born in Crosby, Town of Barrington, Yates County, NY in 1888 the youngest son of Herman Bullock and Drusilla Asenith Finton. Herman Bullock operated a saw mill and grape basket factory at his home in Crosby along the lake. Drusilla's brother, George Washington Finton also owned and operated a basket factory less than a mile north of Herman's factory. *The photo of Homer to the left was taken circa 1911*.

Mary Florence Rector was born in Second Milo, Yates County, NY in 1889 the daughter of Stephen Milton Rector and Minnie Nichols. She graduated from Penn Yan Academy in

1908 and, after being trained at Keuka Normal School, taught in one room schools in Jerusalem and Milo for a year each. *The photo of Mary to*

the right was taken circa 1908.

Homer told many stories about the lake including Glenn Curtiss' practice airplane flights off the lake; how the lake steamers would stop at many points around the lake to pick up passengers and the grape harvest; and how he would swim across the lake. Homer grew up helping his father in the basket factory and saw mill. This is where he learned the love of shaping and treating wood and wood products that stayed with him all his life.

While his three older brothers went to college and one to graduate school, Homer never finished high school. The oldest son, Joseph Finton Bullock went to Colgate University and became District

Superintendent of Schools in Yates County from 1912 to 1948. William Wallace Bullock also graduated from Colgate and went on to graduate school at Columbia University; he was a school



teacher and principal of several schools in New York State. Edgar Bullock went to West Virginia University and graduated as a mechanical engineer. Homer did not graduate from high school; he did attend in North Cohocton and Cuba, NY where his older brother, William, was the principal.

In 1908, Herman and Drusilla bought land and moved to the Isle of

Pines, Cuba. Homer made at least two trip to Santa Fe, Isle of Pines to stay with his parents, but for the most part stayed in the States. *The photo to the left above shows Homer helping his parents prepare for planting on the Isle of Pines*. He did operate the saw mill during the years

between 1905 and 1910 and on one of his jobs he met his future wife, Mary Florence Rector. It seems that while doing some mill work with his portable steam saw mill for S. M. Rector in Second Milo; while on the job he met S. M.'s daughter Mary for the first time.

Homer and Mary were married on 6 September 1911 at the home of her parents. As recorded by the Penn Yan paper "the Rev. Dr. Bethel, pastor of the Second Milo Baptist Church officiated the house was decorated with goldenrod and ferns her sister, Miss Helen Rector was honor maid and Joseph Crosby was groomsman later Mr. Bullock left with his bride for Crosby, where they will reside." Their first child, Herman Stephen, was born in 1913 but died of complications from convulsions at the age four and a half. Philip Gerald was born in 1916 in Penn Yan while his parents were living at the Lown place in Second Milo. Later, while Homer worked for a brief period as a conductor on the trolley between Seneca Falls and Geneva, the family lived in Waterloo, Seneca County.

Homer's brother Edgar had respiratory problems so he went to live with Herman and Drusilla in Cuba sometime after 1910. There he met some Cuban businessmen who wanted a source for crates to package fruits for the West Indies Fruit Importing Company. Edgar was

hired and set out to build and run the Pine-Box Lumber Company at Abra Grande. To help with the factory, Edgar asked Homer to come to the Isle of Pines. So in 1919 Homer, Mary and young Philip Gerald went to live in the tropics. While they were there Ruth Hope Bullock was born in 1920. The photo to the right of Homer, Mary, Phil, and Ruth was taken on the Isle of Pines



in 1920. Mary Florence Rector Bullock would later tell Isle of Pines stories about sweeping large spiders out of their house and the awful tropical heat and humidity. While in Cuba, Homer taught himself to play the saxophone; a talent that helped him later when in East Bloomfield he formed a little musical group to play at banquets and meetings. The family left the Isle of Pines in 1924 to go back to the states so the children, Philip and Ruth, could attend school.

While Homer was in Abra Grande, he became interested in tropical woods, made a study of the different kinds, and found out where they were located on the Isle of Pines. When he returned to Yates County, he teamed up with Howard Swarthout to set up the Woodcraft Products Corporation to make various novelties from tropical woods imported from the Isle of Pines. Howard was the husband of Mary's sister, Helen Egeria Rector. Homer went straight back to Cuba and spent six months collecting the wood. A building was built in Second Milo and turning lathes were assembled but the business never got off the ground. Robert Homer and Calvin Fenton were born to Homer and Mary in 1926 and 1928 respectively. They lived in Penn Yan, Crosby, and Second Milo during this period.

Homer became the manager of the Singer Sewing Machine store in Geneva the summer of 1928, so the family moved to the Herman Brehm house in Waterloo. Paul David was born in that house in 1929, delivered by Dr. Holmes. When the great depression of 1929 came, Homer

lost his job with Singer. He spent the next few years, when he could get the work, delivering coal. While in Waterloo, Philip graduated from high school.

In 1934 Clarence Wemett from Hemlock, NY hired Homer to do wood turning at the Roadside Craftsman in East Bloomfield. The family moved first to the Cook house next to the



Holloway House and across the street from the Congregational Church; then to the Condon house next to the Roadside Craftsman; and then to the Parmalee house which was next to the Page house. The photo to the left shows the Roadside Craftsmen building; Ruth is standing on the right.

During this period Philip worked at the Roadside Craftsman; for Lear Radio in New York City; and for Rittenhouse in Honeoye Falls. He was drafted into the U. S. Army in 1941 and served as a Radio Operator in an Anti-Aircraft Battalion in Australia and New Guinea. Ruth Hope graduated from high school in 1938, earned an R. N. at Genesee Hospital, and married Peter James Vandenbergh Jr. in 1943. Peter served in the U. S. Navy on board ship in the Pacific.

Homer had a variety of interests including raising rare breeds of pigeons, keeping honeybees, making violins, playing saxophone in his orchestra, and studying the Bible. When work became slow at the Roadside Craftsman, Homer worked at a furniture factory in Rochester and during the war worked at a defense plant in Rochester. Because of the economic situation Mary had to work doing housework, picking cherries, sorting peaches and eggs, and baby sitting.



Homer, Mary, and family were members of the First
Methodist Church in East Bloomfield where both taught
Sunday school classes from time to time. *The church is shown in the photo to the right above.*Robert Homer and his family are, at the time of this writing, still members of this church.




In 1944, the Rubinstein house in Holcomb was purchased by Homer and Mary. This home, the first owned by them, was a large home on East Main Street and is presently owned by Richard R. Rayburn. *The Holcomb home is pictured on the left*. The large barn behind the house was remodeled into a wood shop and when Philip was

discharged from the Army in 1945, Homer established his own business which survived for several years. At one time, he had as many as four employees to assist in the fabrication of

wooden items such as professional view camera parts, display cases, novelty boxes, and broom heads. Philip worked with him for a few years as did his son-in-law Peter Vandenbergh Jr. Ruth Hope Bullock Vandenbergh and her son David Peter Vandenbergh lived with Homer and Mary while her husband served in the Navy.

During these years, Robert Homer graduated from high school, served in the U. S. Navy, married Gwendolyn June Morrow, and attended Syracuse University. Calvin Fenton graduated from high school, served in the U. S. Army, married Catherine Helen Jean Spy, graduated from the State University of New York at Oswego, and graduated from Dallas Theological Seminary. Paul David graduated from high school, graduated from State University of New York at Albany, served in the U. S. Army, received a graduate degree from the University of Michigan, and married Anne Barclay Ashman. Mary worked in the wood shop with Homer and later was employed in the Bloomfield Central School cafeteria for several years. *The photo to the right shows Homer and Mary working in the shop.*




During this time, to be close to family, Homer's brother William Wallace and his wife, Harriett, moved to Holcomb across the street from Homer in the Barden house. William Wallace



also moved a small building containing his wood shop from Manchester, NY to an area next to Homer's wood shop; William was an amateur woodworker. The photo to the left shows Mary and Homer at Paul and Anne's wedding in June 1957. Homer died a month later.

This brief story ends with Homer's death in Holcomb in 1957 at the age of 69. Mary survived him by almost 16 years. Both Homer and Mary are buried in the East Bloomfield Cemetery near the Methodist Church.




Thomas J. Rector, 53, member of the village police department for the past three years, died in Soldiers and Sailors Memorials Hospital Tuesday afternoon at 3:15 o'clock, an hour after being admitted to the hospital. Cause of death was given as cerebral hemorrhage.

Patrolman Rector was stricken while seated at a table in the Heath Restaurant, Main Street, about 1:45 p. m., as he was eating his lunch. He was taken in Thayer ambulance to the hospital where he died an hour later without having regained consciousness.

He was born in Milo, son of Stephen and Minnie Nichols Rector and had been engaged in several lines of endeavor including agriculture, men's apparel clerk, and salesman and for the past three years as a member of the police department. He was appointed meter officer in December, 1940, and two years ago received the appointment as patrolman. Patrolman "Tommy" was well liked and was courteous and helpful in his job of serving the public. He was a past master of Penn Yan Grange, member of Hunter Hook & Ladder Company and Methodist Church

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Elizabeth Groden Rector; two daughters, the misses Jean, of Rochester and Phyllis Rector, at home; two sisters, Mrs. Howard Swarthout, Penn Yan, R. D., Mrs. Homer Bullock, East Bloomfield; brother, Rev. Milton Rector, Lincoln, Vermont.

Funeral services will be held this (Friday) afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Methodist Church Rev. E. D. VanDyke, of the Methodist Church, officiating. Burial in Lake View Cemetery.

Windnagle, Mr. and Mrs. Albert Ansley, and Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Rector.



Mr. and Mrs. Rector left that evening for Rochester, where they will make their home at 156 Sheppard St.Arthur worked for many years as the manager of Ward Farms on Bath Road. Gladys worked for many years as a Licensed Practical Nurse. Their four children were all born in Penn Yan, NY: Janice Marie, Richard Joseph, Alan Stuart, and John Stephen. Arthur died in 1936 and Gladys in 1961. They are both buried in Second Milo Cemetery.



Milton graduated from Keuka College in 1906 and Rochester Seminary in 1909. Leona Grace Swarts was born in 1877 in Milo, Yates County, NY the daughter of Marion Swarts and Flora Goundry Swarts.



Milton and Grace were married in 1899 in her maternal

grandfather's home in Milo. The following Penn Yan newspaper article describes the wedding. "MILO, 1899, Dec. 27 - SWARTS - RECTOR, a very beautiful wedding took place at 3 o'clock p.m., at the home of George Goundry when his granddaughter, Miss Leona G. Swarts and Mr. Milton M. Rector were united in marriage under a white horse shoe suspended from an evergreen arch dotted here and there with bows of white ribbon. The house was decorated with evergreens and potted plants. The bride and groom were attended by Miss Kathleen Rector, sister of the groom, as bridesmaid and George Swarts, brother of the bride, as best man, were ushered in by a wedding march played by Mrs. J. A. Guile, Sunday School teacher of the bride. The bride wore a light grey serge trimmed with pink silk, ribbons and white lace and wore white chrysanthemums. The bridesmaid wore a blue dress with light blue trimmings. The sermon was performed by Rev. G. Frank Johnson, during which Mrs. Guile played, very low, "Home Sweet Home," with variations, which was very impressive. The refreshments were bountiful and nicely served. The presents were handsome and useful, Noticeable were one dozen silver knives, eight forks, from Mr. D. A. Bissell, Lowell, Mich. a silver soup ladle and pickle fork, from Miss Lettie McCluskey, Tallapoosa, Ga.; silver mustard cup, from Mr. and Mrs. C. E. Stone, Ottosen, a. silver sugar spoon and butter knife, from Mrs. N. H. Ellis, Jesse, Mich. At six o'clock they

departed for a short wedding trip amid a shower of rice. They will visit friends at Dundee and Cohocton. Mr. and Mrs. Rector have been members of the Second Milo Baptist Church for some time and their host of friends wish them a happy life."

Milton and Grace had three children: Elwyn born in 1908, Verna born in 1911, and Adonna born in 1914. Elwyn died in 1922 at the age of 14. *The 1914 photo to the right shows Verna, Leona holding Adonna, and Elwyn*. In 1924 they adopted Winifred Joyce Rector. Milton



died in 1953 in Walton, NY and Leona died in 1964. They are both buried in the Walton Cemetery in Walton, NY.

Milton's obituary, appearing in a Penn Yan newspaper, follows: "WALTON, N. Y., 1953, Jan.29 - Rev. Milton Medford Rector, native of Gorham died at age 73 in Walton, formerly of Milo. He had been a semiinvalid far the past three years, passing away quietly in his sleep after a ten days



illness. Son of the late Stephen and Jennie Holley Rector, he was born in Gorham and in 1900 married Miss Leona Grace Swarts of Milo, who survives him. Other survivors are three daughters, Mrs. Frank Kubin of Delancey; Mrs. Harry DeGroat of West Hartford, Conn, and Mrs. Melvin Fielder of Shelburne, VT.; and five grandchildren, Their only son, Elwyn, who had



planned to follow his father's calling as a foreign missionary, died at the age of 14. Rev. Rector was a graduate of Keuka College, 1906, and Rochester Seminary, 1909. He held pastorates in New York State and Vermont, having been in Cobleskill for five years and at Walton for nine years. After retiring he had returned to Walton a year and a half ago to make his home. He was a naturalist, knew the birds, made collections of mosses and shells. He was accustomed to speak of his "Father's World," and his favorite hymn being "This Is My Father's World." He had been a nature instructor for several years in a Baptist boys' camp at Ocean Park, Me., and in Baptist camps in New York State and worked in Schoharie and Delaware counties in daily vacation Bible schools. Funeral services far Mr. Rector were on Saturday, Jan. 31, at the First Baptist Church of Walton, with burial in the Walton Cemetery. Rev. Richard Benait was the officiating clergyman, assisted by Rev. Louis F. Kirlin of Trout Creek and Rev. Paul Downes of Delancey."

Catherine Arnold Rector and Clayton Beckwith



Catherine Arnold Rector was born in 1882 in Gorham, Ontario County, NY the daughter of Stephen Milton Rector and Jennie D. Hawley Rector. Her mother died when she was five years old. She spent her childhood living at the Rector homestead with her father; her older brother Milton Medford Rector; her stepmother Minnie Nichols Rector; her halfsisters Mary Florence Rector and



Helen Egeria Rector; and her half-brothers Thomas Jefferson Rector and Arthur Franklin Rector. *The picture of Catherine, to*

the left above, is from a Rector family portrait taken in 1895 when she was 13. Catherine is spelled with a "K" on her gravestone and in the Town of Milo vital record of her marriage.

In 1906 Catherine married Clayton Beckwith in Milo, Yates County, NY with Rev. Leon L. Swarthout officiating. Clayton Beckwith was born in 1885 in Springville, PA the son of Andrew Beckwith and Ida Ricker Beckwith. *The portrait of Clayton, above right, was probably taken at the time of the wedding.* Clayton's occupation is listed as being a "clerk" in the Town of Milo vital record of his marriage. Catherine and Clayton lived in Penn Yan for a time where Clayton was employed in Wegener Bros. shoe store. In 1910, they lived on Third Street in Fulton, Oswego County where Clayton was a shoe dealer. Catherine died in 1912 in Fulton, NY and was buried in Lakeview Cemetery, Penn Yan, Yates County, NY.

Catherine's Obituary - Penn Yan Democrat - January 12, 1912
"BECKWITH -- At Fulton, N. Y., January 5 1912. Mrs. Clayton Beckwith - aged 29 years. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Rector, of Milo, and before going to Fulton she lived in Penn Yan, her husband being employed in Wegener Bros. shoe store. Besides her husband and parents she leaves two sisters Mrs. Homer Bullock, of Barrington, and Miss Helen Rector, of Milo, and three brothers Rev. Milton Rector, of Kingsbury, N. Y., Thomas and Arthur Rector, of Milo. The remains were brought to Milo and the funeral was held Sunday afternoon."

The snapshot to the right is of Catherine and another woman showing off their hats. It was taken in about 1905. Catherine, to the right in the photo, would have been approximately 23 at the time. The other is either her step mother Minnie Nichols Rector or her half-sister Mary Florence Rector. Minnie, only 10 years older than Catherine, would have been approximately 33. Mary would have been 16. The eyeglasses may have been props. *My guess is that the other woman is my mother, Mary Florence Rector (PDB)*.





The Search for Minnie Nichols' Ancestors



Minnie B. Nichols first appears on our radar screen when she is married to Stephen Milton "SM" Rector in Milo, Yates County, NY on August 5, 1888. She was born on November 29, 1872 so she was about 4 months shy of being 16 years old when she was married. The Milo Town Clerk records for her marriage entry show that she was born in Rhode Island, her father was Thomas Nichols, she was from Second Milo, and the Pastor was F. Shirer. The entry for the birth of her firstborn, Mary Florence, on July 9, 1889 shows that her maiden name was Minnie Rector and her birthplace was "don't know." When

Minnie's son Arthur was born in

1892 the birth record say her place of birth was Brooklyn.

Minnie's death certificate says she was born in Kansas. The lines for parents and their birthplaces were filled in with "cannot be learned." The information was given by her daughter Mrs. Howard Swarthout of Buffalo.

Minnie shows up on the 1892 census in Milo, age 21. Stephen M Rector was 39 and they lived with his mother, three children by Minnie and two from his first marriage to Jennie D. Hawley. In the same household was a young man named George Nichols, age 22. He may have been Minnie's brother, but there were so many Nichols in the neighborhood (including another Minnie)

that this certainly is not yet proven. There was a Minnie Nichols, the daughter of Loring and Charlotte Nichols, living in Nichols Corners, Milo, NY in 1870. The 1870 census lists her as being 13 years old; this Minnie, then, was born in 1857. She seems a little too old to be our Minnie

Minnie told her daughter, Mary Florence Rector Bullock, that she came from Missouri. Frank Swarthout says that Minnie told his mother Helen Egeria Rector Swarthout (Minnie's other daughter), that she came from Kansas with the McGilliards. Her birthplace and the identity of her father and mother remain a mystery to this day.

Several attempts have been made to learn more about Minnie's past. The Yates County Historian, Frances Dumas, has been very helpful in tracking down information on Minnie. One such attempt was to put known information about Minnie on the "Nichols' Forum" website on the internet. One response from W. Earle Nichols has lead to some interesting speculation. The

Minerva "Minnie" Nichols in Missouri in the 1870s and 1880s

The story goes that James Nichols, Missouri Minnie's father, came from a foundling home in Ireland. He stowed away on a ship to America at age 9. He stayed on the ship as a cabin boy for a few years before he started work on a cargo ship on the Mississippi River.

The oldest record of James is from an 1856 Iowa State Census of Henry Co., Tippecanoe Township. He was married to Mary Hobson and they had 4 children at the time. Mary and James had 10 children total before Mary died in 1871. The children were:

- 1. Elias b. 1847 moved to Vernon Co., MO and married P. Graham
- 2. Laura Ann b. 1850 married Edward Ralls (Rawls) and lived in Mercer Co., in 1880
- 3. Virginia b. 1853 in 1880 was still living at home at age 27.

- 5. Martha b. 1857
- 6. John C. F. b. 1860
- 7. Curtis b. 1863
- 8. Emma b. 1864
- 9. Clara b. 1867
- 10. Catherine (Katie) b. 1869 married Cornelius (Neal?) A. Baldwin (son of Lucinda Cooper Baldwin who later married Catherine's father)

After Mary died, James Nichols married Lucinda Cooper Baldwin on 25 Mar 1873. Lucinda already had 5 children with James S. Baldwin. These 5 Baldwin children were Marion, Oliver, Elmira, Cornelius, and Louise. James and Lucinda Nichols had the following children:

- 1. Minnie Nichols born about 1874
- 2. Arthur Lee Nichols born 12 Oct 1877 married Lucy Ethel Kidwell
- 3. Thomas Nichols born 30 Nov 1879 married Clara Kidwell
- 4. Eldred Taylor "Sly" Nichols born 8 Apr 1882 married Virginia "Jennie" Kidwell
- 5. Fred Nichols born 20 Jun 1886

The 1880 Federal Census of Medicine Township, Mercer Co., MO lists James, Lucinda, Minnie, Arthur and Thomas. Minnie is listed as being 6 years old on June 1, 1880. Claudia Swanson (Arthur Lee Nichols' daughter and Earl Nichols' aunt) said that Minnie's given name was Minerva and that she died at an early age. No record of her birth, death or burial place has been found.

The James and Lucinda Nichols family moved from Mercer Co., MO to Rich Hill, Vernon Co., MO sometime in the 1880s. That part of Vernon Co., MO is now in Bates Co., MO. They moved there to work in the coal mines. It is not known whether Minnie (Minerva) moved with the family.

James Nichols died in Osage, Vernon Co., MO on 9 Jan 1894. Arthur Lee, Thomas, and Eldred Taylor Nichols and their families all moved to the Boise Valley, Idaho in the early 1900s.

Miscellaneous Comments by Earl Nichols

- 1. The name McGilliard does not ring a bell
- 2. I am not aware of any of the family moving to Kansas
- 3. The Nichols' house in Medicine Twp., Mercer Co., MO in the 1870s was not very large and the five Baldwin children were "farmed out" to Cooper relatives and neighbors. Some of the Baldwin children are listed as servants in those households on the 1880 Census. It is possible that Minnie (Minerva) may have been raised by one of the Baldwin girls in the family.
- 4. There has been a family story that has filtered down about a couple of the children (Baldwin or Nichols?) went to New York and were involved in the stage production of "Abie's Irish Rose." The story has not been authenticated.
- 5. My Minerva may have been born in Mercer Co., MO or in Vernon Co., MO.

Excerpts from a Mercer County, MO History

JAMES S, AND LUCINDA (COOPER) BALDWIN

James S. Baldwin was born ca 1836 in Illinois and died September 21, 1870, of hemorrhage of the lungs (contracted while a prisoner in 1862 in Montgomery, Alabama). James was married by George Odneal, JP, on June 28, 1857, in Mercer County, Missouri, to Lucinda Cooper. She was born April 8, 1841, in Indiana and died in February 1905 in Vernon County, Missouri. She was the daughter of Starling and Lucinda (Callicott) Cooper (see Starling Cooper Jr. history).

James enlisted in the Civil War in Mercer County on October 18, 1861, as a private in Co. G, 23rd MO Vol. He was honorably discharged on January 24, 1865.

Lucinda is said to have been short, somewhat feisty, with a dark complexion, and it is also said that she spoke Gaelic.

James and Lucinda had five children, all of whom were born near Half Rock, Medicine Township, Mercer County, Missouri:

- 1) Marion A. was born September 6, 1858, and married first Lucinda Ellen Ganiott (see John William Garriott history); he married second Maggie . M. A. died in 1903 in Oregon. M. A. and Lucinda's children were Lloyd (August 17, 1883 -), Roy Alvin (January 2, 1885), Walter and Alma (they died young and are buried in the Barnes Cemetery). His children by Maggie were Virgil and Orville.
- 2) Oliver Franklin "Frank" was born November 1, 1859, and married Melda J. Lowry. Three of their children were Gracie, Amber L. and Roy A. Roy died on June 25, 1903, at age 17 years, two months and five days and is buried in the Harris Cemetery.
- 3) Elmira was born July 18, 1861, and married Moses Snyder Voils. They are found in the 1900 Sheridan, Wyoming, census. They had nine children with six living at the time of the census. Those listed are Minnie Mabel (December 1883). Alva D. (June 1884), James (August 1890), Dora L. (January 1892), Wesley (November 1893). Two of their infant children are buried in the Half Rock Cemetery.
- 4) Cornelius "Neil" A. was born January 26, 1866, and married Kate Nichols.

5) Louisa was born November 26 1868, and is on the 1880 Medicine Township, Mercer County census as age 13 and living with Shadrack and Rebecca (Stanton) Cooper (no further information).

JAMES AND LUCINDA (COOPER) BALDWIN NICHOLS

James Arthur Nichols was born ca 1825 in Missouri and died January 9, 1894. He was married on June 12, 1845. to Mary Hobson. She died July 14, 1871. James was then married by Rev. James Voils on March 2, 1873, in Princeton, Mercer County, Missouri, to Mrs. Lucinda (Cooper) Baldwin.

James enlisted on September 10, 1861, as a first lieutenant in Co. A, 7th Reg't., MO State Militia, in the Civil War at Wintersville, Sullivan County, Missouri. He served in Jonas Clark's Mercer County Battalion and was honorably discharged on March 12, 1862.

James and Lucinda had five children, all of whom were born near Half Rock:



Minnie B. Nichols in Yates Co., NY from 1888 Through 1938

- 1. Minnie Nichols married Stephen Milton Rector in Milo Twp., Yates Co., NY on 5 Aug 1888. The Milo Town Clerk marriage record shows that she was age 17, Thomas Nichols was her father, she was from Second Milo, Yates, Co., NY, and she was born in Rhode Island.
- 2. Mary Florence Rector was born on 9 Jul 1889. The Milo Town Clerk birth record shows that her father was S. M. Rector aged 39, her mother was Minnie Rector aged 20, her mother's maiden name was Minnie Rector, and her mother's birthplace was "don't know."

 - a) Mary Florence Rector b. 1889
 - b) Thomas Jefferson Rector b. 1890
 - c) Helen Egeria Rector b. 1891

- 6. Minnie shows up on the 1892 census in Milo, age 21. Stephen M Rector was 39 and they lived with his mother, three children by Minnie and two from his first marriage to Jennie. In the same household was a young man named George Nichols, age 22.
- 7. Mary Florence Rector Bullock told her children that her mother, Minnie, came from Missouri. Frank Swarthout, Minnie's grandson, was told that Minnie came from Kansas with the McGilliard family.
- 8. Minnie was very close to Carrie McGilliard Razev and Frances Harmon Townsend McGilliard. Minnie's daughter, Mary, always called Carrie Razey, "Aunt Carrie." Minnie and S. M. Rector held a party to honor Earle and Frances McGilliard after their wedding in 1905. Earle was her second husband; nothing is known of her first husband, Mr. Townsend. However, the Yates County surrogate

court records yield a petition on the part of Frances S. Townsend of Milo for the possessions of her late husband, Alvah E. Townsend of Milo; Alvah died 27 May 1900. Frances Harmon was born in 1868 in Northumberland Co., PA and died at 100 in 1968 in Lakeland, FL. Her father was P. H. Harmon and her mother Mary Carey. Minnie Nichols Rector's obituary in 1938 says that Minnie was survived by her sister Mrs. Frances McGilliard of Lakeland, FL.

Could the Missouri Minnie be the Yates Minnie?

1. The naming pattern of her children gives some credibility to the hypothesis. Our Minnie used three of the six names of Missouri Minnie's brothers in the four names of her sons,

Four Brother's Names Arthur Lee Thomas Eldred Taylor Fred Two Son's Names Thomas Jefferson Arthur Frederick

Naming patterns are often used by genealogists as clues for determining family connections.

- 2. Could it be that, in addition to our Minnie Nichols being the Missouri Minnie, Frances Harmon is Louisa Baldwin, her half-sister. Frances was born in 1868, the same year that the youngest Baldwin girl, Louisa, was born. William Earl Nichols stated that, based on the 1880 census, Louisa was living with Cooper relatives in Mercer Co., MO and listed as a servant. There is no record of Louisa after the 1880 census. Cleveland's 1873 Yates History states that Robert Preston McGilliard, his wife Charlotte Green McGilliard, and their son, Earle Durward McGilliard were living in Saxon, Henry Co., IL at the time the history was written. Charlotte's brother, Champion, and his wife also lived in Illinois. Other Green families and Robson families also lived in IL and subsequently moved on to locations in MO, IA, and KS. In 1873 the Nichols/Baldwin/Cooper families were in Half Rock, Mercer Co., MO; a little more than 100 miles from Henry Co., IL. Although the McGilliards returned to Yates county (the 1875 state census lists the family, including Carrie, as living in Italy, NY) they could have maintained a relationship with the Nichols/ Baldwin/Cooper families out west. The middle initial, in Minnie B. Nichols, could stand for Baldwin. Possibly Minnie went to live, as a servant, with the same Cooper family in Half Rock, MO where Louisa Baldwin lived.
- 3. There is no real evidence, other than her children's interpretation of Minnie's own words, to support the fact that she came from Missouri or Kansas to Yates County sometime before 1888. Although there is no cemetery record or other official record of her death, the Missouri Nichol's descendants have always believed that she died young in Missouri.

Is Missouri Minnie the same person as Minnie B. Nichols Rector? Maybe. Efforts are continuing to get more information on Minnie B. Nichols Rector's background.

In one of a series of articles contributed in 1869, to the Yates County Chronicle, concerning the "Yates County Gazetteer," Edward J. Fowle, wrote as follows: "After the earlier settlers of Benton, about 1816, there came a colony from Livingston's Manor, Columbia county, who located in the west part of the town, which for many years was designated as the West or Dutch Woods. They were an honest, frugal and industrious people. The 'Old Folks' are nearly all departed, as are most of the log houses they built. Many of the descendants reside there, possessing the virtues of the parents. They are well-to-do farmers, and good livers. Among them will be found the family names: Crank, Rector, Finger, Wheeler, Simmons, Carrol, Hoos, Moon, Miller and Niver. In the young days of the old people, the winters afforded good times for visiting and social enjoyments. Every week, if not oftener, at the log residence of some one of them, the families would all congregate, coming in sleighs or sleds, when there would be music and dancing, story telling, refreshments and smoking, while the huge logs blazed sway in the good large fire-places; and so the evening or night passed away. There was usually one double log house, with only one room below, which had two fireplaces, two looms, two beds, and other furniture, and occupied by two families. And those primitive times were happy times with them, with few artificial wants, with no heed to fashions, no class distinctions, no envyings nor jealousies, their lives glided along smoothly and pleasantly. Their spiritual wants were supplied occasionally by an itinerant Dutch or Methodist minister. They were always kind to one another, at house raisings and logging bees, at marriages, in sickness and at death and burial. The large and small wheel, the reel and the loom, have nearly disappeared from among them, but agriculture, the dairy, poultry flocks and herds; and general household duties, now claim the attention of both men and women, old and young, conducing to health and competence. They have rarely if ever been engaged in law suits, and never has one of them been before the courts for wrong doing. It would be hard for our friends in high life to frame for themselves a more exalted eulogy."

THE RECTOR FAMILY

Andrew Rector was a native of Copake, originally Taghkanick, Columbia Co., N. Y., and was born in 1762. He married Charity Rockefellow, of the same place. He died in Benton, in 1842, at the age of eighty, and she in 1838, at the age of seventy-two. They came to Benton in 1817, bringing most of their family of nine children, and settled in the West Woods, on lot 104, where there was no house or clearing, buying the land of Samuel Colt, of Geneva, who was a considerable landholder in that vicinity, and paying ten dollars per acre. Here they tarried the remainder of their days. Their children were (1) William, (2) Hannah, (3) Mary, (4) Teal, (5) Andrew, (6) Eva, (7) Christiana, (8) Catharine and (9) Elizabeth.

1) William, born in 1782, married Hannah Simmons, in Columbia county. They settled in Benton, in 1810, and on lot 101, in 1813, coming with Henry Simmons previous to his father. Hannah, his wife, was born in 1786, and died in 1870. Their children were Elizabeth, Andrew W., Conrad, Jacob, Charity, David, Catharine and William J.

- Elizabeth, daughter of William Rector, born in 1806, married James Jennings, of Benton, where she died. Her children were Hannah, Thomas, William J., Nelson, Sarah and Jerusha. Hannah married Jesse Tiers, of Benton. They reside on the Pottertown road, and have one child, Hannah. Thomas married Anna Wheat, of Benton. They reside in Naples, and have six children. William married Cynthia Kirkham, of Benton. They settled in Naples, and have three children. J. Nelson married Ursula Wheat, of Benton, a sister of the wife of Thomas, and has resided with his father. He has a second wife, Annie E. Washburn, of Naples. They reside now in Penn Yan. Sarah married John Miller, resides in Michigan, and has one child. Jerusha married William Washburn, of Naples, and has one child.
- Andrew W., son of William Rector, born in 1806, married Elizabeth Coons, of Benton, and settled in Potter. He has held the office of justice of the peace in that town several years. Their children are Nelson, Hannah E., Sarah C., Emily J., Amelia M. and Julian. Nelson married Caroline Coons, of Naples, and resided in Benton, where she died, leaving two children, Elizabeth and William. He has a second wife, Harriet Shaw, of Benton, and there are two children of the second marriage, Caroline and Andrew. Hannah E. is unmarried. Sarah married Orson Linkletter, of Steuben county. They reside in Naples. Emily married Daniel Reynolds, of Middlesex, and resides in Michigan. They have one child, Llewellyn. Amelia M. married Daniel Olcott, of Naples, where they reside. They have one child. Julia married Addison Hasley, of Potter, and resides with her
- Conrad Rector, born in 1809, married Mary Wheeler, of Benton, and settled in Naples. They have one child, Caroline.
- Jacob, born in 1812, married Maria Coons, of Benton, and resides in Naples. They have one son, John.
- Catharine, born in 1822, married Seymour Wheeler, of Potter, and resides in Naples. Their children are Werder, Malcolm and Hannah.
- Charity, born in 1815, married John Rector, of Benton.
- David, born in 1815, married Susan Bates, of Potter, and resides in Naples. They have one child, Hannah.
- William J. born in 1826, married Cataline Kelsey, of Benton, and resides with his father on the homestead. He is an enterprising and thrifty farmer. He has a second wife, Eleanor, daughter of Thomas Davis, of Benton.
- 2) Hannah, daughter of Andrew Rector, senior, married Henry Simmons.
- 3) Mary married Christian Niver, of Columbia county. They did not come to this county. Their children were Andrew, Elizabeth, Henry, Charity, Hannah, Catharine, Mary B. and Norman. Elizabeth and Catharine only became residents of this county.
 - Elizabeth Niver married Col. William Carroll, and settled in Benton, where she died, leaving seven children, James, Peter D., Alfred, Ann, William, Worthy and Mary E.
 - Col. Carroll married a second wife, Catharine Niver, sister of his first wife. Their children were Adelaide; Hannah J., Mercena and Frank. William Carroll was the successor of Col. Gilbert Sherer, as colonel of the old 103d regiment of Militia. He died in 1860, at the age of fifty-one. His son James Carroll is a Methodist clergyman. He is married, and resides in Connecticut. Peter D. married Mary J. Miller, of Columbia Co., and resides on a portion of the paternal homestead, on lot 106. Their children are Jane, Deloss, Seneca, Gazelle and Floyd. Alfred

married Sarah Doremus, of Penn Yan, and resides on the place known as the Lovejoy farm, south of Cranks Corners. Their children are Grace, Charles and Fred. Baron married Mary, daughter of Simon Forshay, of Penn Yan. They reside in Torrey, on the Penn Yan and Dresden road, and their children are Job and Will. William married Alice Niver, of Columbia county, and resides there. Mary E. is the wife of William Miner Taylor, of Benton. Worthy is single, and is one of the firm of S. J. Larham & Co., grocers, and resides in Penn Yan. Adelaide married Charles Swarthout, of Torrey, and resides on the Swarthout family homestead. They have one son, Henry. Hannah J. married Dudley Olney, of Torrey. They reside at Ypsilanti, Michigan. Marcena and Frank are unmarried, and reside in Penn Yan.

- 4) Teal Rector, born in 1789, married Eleanor Finger, of Columbia county, and settled on the homestead in Benton, where he died, in 1859, leaving eight children: Charity, John, Jacob T., Eliza, William T., Simeon, and Lucetta and Lewis, twins.

The Richters Before Andrew Rector (Andreas Richter)

Notes on Our Richter Ancestors

This story begins in the Electoral Palatinate in Germany in the years before 1709. The Palatinate was and is the area in Germany next to France and Belgium along the Rhine river and is presently called the Rhine-Palatinate or Pfalz. The War of the Palatinate in the late 1600's and the War of the Spanish Succession in the very early 1700's left this area ravaged and desolate. This caused many peasants and common people to be left homeless and destitute. Beginning in 1708, numbers of Palatines went to England in hopes to go on to the colonies. In 1709, about thirteen thousand (13,000) families entered England.

According to a list taken in Walworth, England on May 27, 1709, one of these families was the John Andreas Richter family. Listed with John Andreas is his wife, a 14 year old son, and daughters of ages 17, 7, and 3. The list shows John Andreas to be 46 years old, his religion Lutheran, and his vocation husbandman or vinedresser. There is no information on from where in Germany the family came.

In England, the Board of Trade proposed that the Palatines go to the colonies to make naval stores. In 1710, approximately three thousand (3,000) became British citizens and the British officials sent them to New York. The naval stores operation never prospered so most, of those who stayed in the new world, became farmers.

Andreas Richter name appears in Governor Hunter's New York subsistence list from the time of his landing in 1710 to September 1712. The list includes an Andreas Richter and with a family of 3 adults (over 10 years old) and 2 children in 1710. In 1712, a similar list shows 3 adults and no children. The Colonial Census of 1710 includes Andreas (age 47), his wife Anna Maria (45), son Andreas (16), and daughter Anna Barbara (9). So apparently the eldest daughter listed in England married and at least one younger daughter died in New York.

Probably the Richters moved up the Hudson in 1712 to the "West Camp" on the western bank of the river to Beckmansland. Beckmansland consisted of the towns of Elizabeth Town, George Town, and New Town. New Town is probably the present city of Newburgh, N.Y. In the Kocherthau Records, records of Pastor Kocherthau who was with the Palatine settlement, Anna Maria and Andreas were sponsors at the christening of Andreas Sutz on February 21, 1713. Then less than two months later, on April 7, 1713, the Kocherthau Records list the marriage of Johann Fuehrer to Anna Marie Richter widow of the late Andreas Richter of New Town. So Andreas Sr. died sometime in that two month period in 1713.

The Kocherthau Records list the birth of Johannes Richter to Andreas and Elisabeth on September 21, 1714. This birth was probably in New Town since the Simmendinger Register lists Andreas, wife Elisabeth and one child as living there. Ulrich Simmendinger, one of the immigrants, published the Simmendinger Register when he returned to Germany. Young Andreas moved across the Hudson to Livingston Manor since he, as Andries Rightster, is shown as a Palatine debtor of the four villages of Germantown, Livingston, Clermont, and Claverack on the dates of March 1, 1718; December 26, 1718 and February 1722. His debts may have stemmed from the time he was on the New York subsistence rolls ten years earlier.

The following are miscellaneous items that mention Richters in the Livingston Manor area:

- 1. Anna Maria is born in 1732 to Andreas (probably Andreas Jr.) and Elisabeth Richter.
- 2. Anna is born to Hannes (probably Johannes the son of Andreas Jr. mentioned above) and Lisabeth Richter in 1747.
- 3. Reformed Church membership list of 1750 mentions Andreas (probably Andreas Jr.) Regter, his wife Anna Elisabeth Stael, and children Maria Elisabeth and Catharina.
- 4. The Livingston Account Book lists Andris Richter as a tenant for various years between 1768 and 1782. Probably this Andreas is a son of Andreas Jr. or Johannes.
- 5. Tax lists of 1779 list Andreas Righter (this and the next two items may be the Andreis Rechter mentioned in the next paragraph).
- 6. John Curry's mill list of customers has several entries for Ander Righter under wheat, corn, barley, etc. in years 1783 and 1784.
- 7. Andreas Richter is a Livingston tenant in 1799.
- 8. Robert Livingston Estate lists Ander Righter as owing 50 cents in 1804.

How we make the genealogical connection from the Andreas Richter Jr., who came to America from Germany via England with his father John Andreas Richter, to the Andreis Rechter, shown living in Columbia County in the 1790 Federal Census, is not totally clear from the records I have seen. The simple fact that there were many Richters along the Hudson River between 1710 and 1800 causes some confusion. Based on the records available, the following seems a reasonable genealogical speculation:

- 1. John Andreas Richter, his wife Anna Maria and children came from the Palatinate to England in 1709 and then to New York in 1710. One child was Andreas who was born in 1694
- 2. Andreas Richter and his wife Anna Elisabeth Stahl had a son, Johan Wilhelm Richter born in 1740 in Rhinebeck, New York.
- 3. **Speculation -** Johan Wilhelm Richter and his first wife (name unknown), had a son Andreas (Ander, Andris) Richter (Righter, Rechter) born in 1762 in Columbia County, New York. He later had a second wife Margaretha Kohl.
- 4. This last Andreas Rechter was born in 1762, married Gertje Rockenfelder in 1781, had several children, and moved from Columbia County to Yates County with most of his children in 1817. When he arrived in Benton, Yates County, his name was Andrew Rector and his wife's name was Charity.

It is speculation that I make Johan Wilhelm Richter the father of Andrew Rector instead of his brother Johannes. The reason I did this is that Johannas had a son Andreas in 1742; this son married Eva Reifenberger and subsequently had a son named Andreas born in 1777. Since my Andrew Rector was born in 1762 about halfway between the births of Johannes' son and grandson, I conclude that Johan Wilhelm is the father. Both brothers lived in the area that my Andrew came from so it is highly likely that Andrew was the son of one or the other.
